Food Shed Co-op chooses builder for new grocery store

McHenry County Food Cooperative has chosen Gallant Building Solutions to build the first grocery store cooperative in McHenry County.

According to a news release, the two companies have signed a building contract, giving Gallant the official go-ahead to begin preliminary work on the co-op's Woodstock property at U.S. 14 and Lake Shore Drive. Official groundbreaking will be announced soon.

The store will have a full range of grocery departments, with produce being the signature category, the release said. When open, the store will be 9,000 square feet and offer about 5,000 different items.
