Building is Underway

Have you driven past the Food Shed Co-op property lately? Things are looking very different than they were in early summer. Our builders, [Gallant Building Solutions](#), have been hard at work since our official groundbreaking on July 18, 2023. Site preparation began even before that date with brush removal and earthmoving to create access to the site for work vehicles and large machinery.



Work, to date, includes excavation and pouring of the foundation. The excavation activity prepared the earth for the building, the eventual parking area and the landscaping for water retention. The foundation work included installing forms and

rebar and pouring concrete for the building footings and then installing footing ground wire and cutting sleeves for the foundation wall.

We are thrilled to have pictorial documentation provided by Gallant. We hope you share in our excitement as we watch our store start to take shape.

Keeping you up-to-date on other progress


Last month we gave an update to our supporters about our Community Investment Campaign's progress. Our goal is to raise the money needed to bridge the gap created by increased material costs and the higher interest rates that developed since the completion of our original campaign. We are excited to share that we currently have less than \$100,000 to raise of the \$485,000 total announced in April, with the campaign deadline on August 31, 2023.

Green Living Expo


McHenry County College
